Kilcummin GAA

Kilcummin GAA club was officially founded in 1910 and first affiliated to the Kerry County Board in 1913. Kilcummin contested the senior county championship final in 1903, 1913 and again in 2002. Kilcummin won the first ever East Kerry League competition in 1925 and to this day remains a competitive presence in East Kerry and County Competitions.

Over the decades Kilcummin GAA has evolved and has become a fulcrum at the centre of community life in Kilcummin. From the development of juvenile teams through Bórd na nÓg, which supports football for boys, to the establishment of the ladies GAA club who cater for girls from 10 years to adults and the establishment of hurling within the club in conjunction with St. Pat's. Kilcummin GAA Club has continued to be progressive and inclusive and has been a cornerstone of the local community for over 100 years.

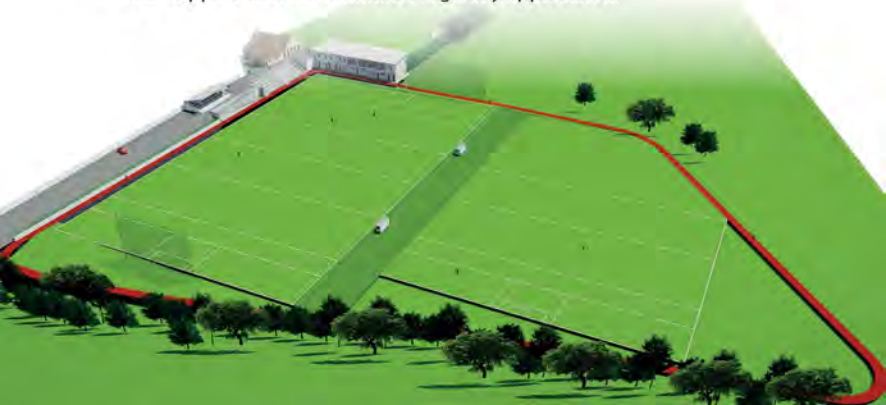
Currently the club has a growing club membership of over 400 adult and juvenile members. The club is vibrant at underage level with over 15 boys' and girls' teams in all age groups from under 6 to under 16 and runs a weekly juvenile academy catering for boys and girls from 5 to 10 years. The men's senior team has been a senior championship club team since 1998 and the ladies senior team continue to go from strength to strength. Kilcummin has been well represented in Scór and the club has 5 All-Ireland titles.

Club facilities are used by the three primary schools in the parish for the Cumann na mBunscoil competitions and is also used as a venue for East Kerry Board, Kerry County Board and second-level colleges competitions. The Club facilities are used and available to other community groups, including Kilcummin Day Care Centre for senior citizens, Kilcummin Rambling House community fundraisers, social and cultural events.

The club celebrated its centenary year in 2010 by winning the County Minor Championship Title and as we now move through the 2nd centenary of our existence, the club has developed a masterplan for the future development and success of the Club for the years ahead. It is now important to invest and provide modern facilities and infrastructure for our growing membership.

With that in mind, this new development will take a whole of life approach so that all people in the community regardless of age, gender or ability may enjoy the use of the facilities in both a sporting and social capacity.

Work completed to date

The Club has been on an exciting journey over the last 24 months with extensive works completed and the adoption of a comprehensive master plan for the future development of the club. Significant progress has been made including:

- Acquisition of land (3.22 acres) for training pitch (€50,000)
- Trunking and filling of training area (c. €70,000)
- Professional works contract for construction of training pitch – to grass level (€128,000)
- Acquisition of additional land from St Brendan's Trust to advance masterplan (€12,000)

The total cost and spend to date of circa €260,000 has been funded by previous fundraisers and a Sports Capital Grant of €100,000.

Together we can enhance the lives of the entire community and leave a legacy for future generations.



Next Phase *(New Facilities)*

- Completion of Training Pitch and associated groundworks
- Walking / Running Track around perimeter of pitches
- New Purpose Built Accessible Building incorporating:
 - Dressing Rooms and Showers
 - Treatment Room
 - Accessible Changing Rooms
 - Referee Room
 - Training Equipment Store
 - Fitness Area / Gym
 - Meeting Room
 - Office
 - Access Ramps and Terrace
 - Parking

The development of these new, improved and inclusive facilities will encourage and increase the active participation for everyone in the club and community.

It is envisaged that the development will be funded through support from the 2017 Sports Capital Programme, club fundraising initiatives, sponsorship of building materials, members' time and energy with their relevant skill sets and future Sports Capital Programmes.
